"It's nothing serious; he is more someone she enjoys spending time with but I don't think it will be her next big romance."

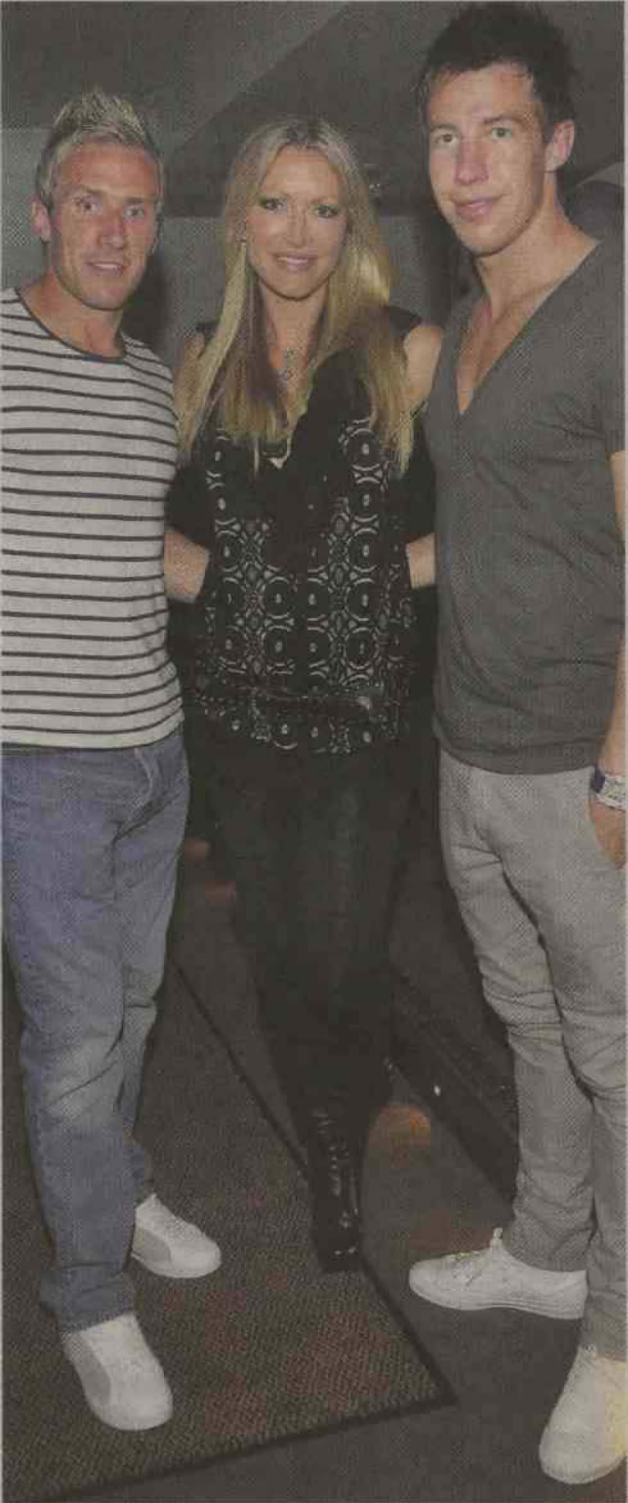
